HFT Rules

1. Scope may be adjusted for Target 1. After that no adjustment to scope is allowed.
2. Shots must be taken Standing, Kneeling or Prone.
3. Some part of your body must touch the peg which will be in the ground.
4. One shot only per target.
5. Scoring:-
Knockdown = 2 points Plate = 1 point
Miss = No points
6. All cards must be signed by a fellow competitor.
